15. Small School Re-Investment Ideas

As we have raised some money from small events it was decided it would be nice to invest some money in the school. It was decided that the School Council is to be approached for ideas as to what students would like, also a form quiz to see what parents would like.

It was also agreed that FoDC would like to help war torn Ukraine. Items from a list were selected to promote to students for them to bring in that would be collected by FoDC and then passed on to a local charity that would then be delivering them to Poland to help people of Ukraine.
