Due to the overwhelming interest and limited capacity for the residential trips, each student will have the opportunity to select their preferences by indicating a first and second choice. This ensures that we can accommodate as many students as possible and align them with their preferred experiences.

We anticipate a high demand for these incredible opportunities and while we will make every effort to accommodate everyone's first choice, it may not always be possible. However, we want to assure you that this is the beginning of a new tradition at Dormston School. We plan to run these trips annually, giving every student the chance to participate in the future if they do not secure their preferred choice this year.

To ensure fairness and transparency, in cases where a trip becomes oversubscribed, we will select students through a ballot process. We are committed to making this process as equitable as possible. As Ingestre Hall places will be through invites, this option will NOT be available to pick at this stage. Students who wish to go on this trip will await further details from Mr Richardson. Please note that if you do successfully gain a place on one of the 3 other trips students will not be able to change this place to Ingestre Hall, if they receive an invite to this at a later stage. Additionally, for the 2024 Activities Week, Year 10 students will be given priority when selecting their preferred residential opportunity. We recognise that this is their final Active Learning Week opportunity and we want to ensure that they have the opportunity to make the most of this experience before moving on to their next academic journey.
