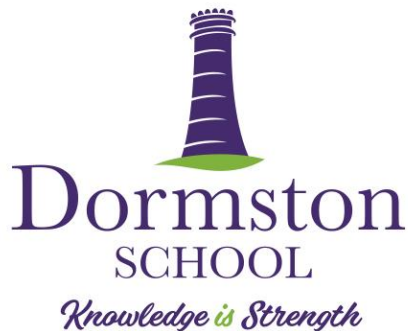

Re: Year 11 Leaving Arrangements

Study Leave

In assembly this afternoon, we told our hardworking Year 11 that this will be their final normal school day and that their official Study Leave now begins. This will mean that pupils will **only be required to come into school for their actual timetabled exams or for pre-exam revision sessions.**

Exam Preparation

As you would expect, pupils should arrive to school in **full school uniform** and be **fully equipped** with what they need contained in a transparent pencil case. Your child will need:

1. Blue/black pens;
2. Pencils (already sharpened);
3. Clear pencil case;
4. Ruler;
5. Rubber;
6. Highlighter (should they use them);
7. Scientific calculator (used in Maths and Science papers), protractor etc.

Morning Exams - Complimentary breakfast

Toast and fruit will be provided for all our Year 11s. **This will be available from 8.20 am** in the Atrium.

Complimentary Lunch

If your child has two exams on the same day, they will be provided with a complimentary meal. Their lunch time will be at the slightly earlier time of 12:45 to accommodate this in preparation for their afternoon exam.

Leavers' Assembly

Our traditional tear-filled Leavers' Assembly will take place in the theatre on Friday 21st June 2024 at 9.00am. This will be a chance for pupils to say 'Goodbye' to friends, teachers and Form Tutors, many of whom they may never bump into again. **Please ensure that your child arrives for this assembly in full school uniform (including shoes and not trainers). Pupils who aren't in full school uniform will not be permitted to take part in the assembly.**
