International Stand Up for Bullying Day - Friday 28 February 2025




Year 11 Theatre Trip 'An Inspector Calls' - Wednesday 5 March 2025

World Book Day - Thursday 6 March 2025



Layla competed in the Year 8 and 9 age group, running 2.5km in 8 minutes 25 seconds and came away as Champion! This has gained her automatic selection to represent West Midlands schools in the English Schools Cross Country Championships, taking place on Saturday 15 March at the South of England Showground, Ardingly, East Sussex! Active Citizenship Project - Finley Purchase - 11TY

We just wanted to share Finley Purchase's brilliant and ambitious 'Active Citizenship Project' with you! Finley has a real passion for History, so set himself the task of getting the old First World War South Staffordshire Regiment Territorial Army Drill Hall and Recruitment Office re-located from its resting place on the Sedgley Road, to the Black Country Living Museum! Finley emailed MPs and the Museum itself and received a reply from the Head of Preservation at the museum saying that he was interested in his proposition, but the museum couldn't take on the project due to their current development with the recreation of Woodside Library as part of their 1940s-60s Street, however, they asked Finley for an overview of his Citizenship GCSE course, and then offered for him to help them with the Woodside Library project as an alternative. Even though Finley's campaign to get the drill hall restored and relocated to the museum was not as successful as he had hoped, he still plans on continuing with his preservation project so that he can hopefully be the spark that lights the fire to help rescue this once crucial building that played a role in our local areas wartime past back to her former glory.
