






May 2025

Year 11 GCSEs - WC Monday 28 April onwards

Year 11 final GCSE exams begin W/C Monday 28 April 2025. These exams are the culmination of five years of hard work and it is important that pupils are fully prepared. Exam timetables have been shared with pupils already and a timetable of pre-exam sessions will be shared with them shortly. Pupils must remember that they need to follow all rules and regulations within the exam hall. It is vital that pupils attend school for each exam and turn up on time. We are unable to provide a time to 're-do' an exam if a pupil misses it because they are absent from school or turn up late. Please ensure your child knows when their exams are and that they attend school well prepared and with all correct equipment. GCSE results day is on Thursday 21 August 2025.



Year 10 Mock Exams - Commencing from Friday 2 May 2025

Year 10 Mock GCSE exams will start on Friday 2 May 2025 and will continue after May half-term. These exams will reflect GCSE exam procedures and will take place in the Sports Hall under full exam conditions. High expectations will be in place for pupil's behaviour and conduct during these exams. Pupils have already had an assembly on the rules and regulations set out by the JCQ which we will be adhering to during the mock exams. It is vital that pupils attend school for each mock exam as there may not be a chance for pupils to 'catch up.' The results of this first set of Mocks will play a major role in staff generating their first 'predicted grades' for students outlining where we would expect them to be by the end of Year 11. Timetables have been shared with pupils and are on GO4Schools and the school website. Please ensure your child is revising for these exams and that they attend school well prepared and with all correct equipment.



May Bank Holiday - Monday 5 May 2025

In **Year 9** all pupils will sit exams in the compulsory subjects (English, Maths and Science). However, for all other subjects, students will only sit exams for the subjects they have chosen for GCSE if they currently study the subject - for 'new' subjects (and a few others) these exams will not be possible. Please ensure your child is revising for these exams and that they attend school well prepared.
