

**97% attendance** – gives a year 11 student a progress score of +1. On average, this means that in every subject the student gets 1 grade higher than expected in every subject.

**95% attendance** – The progress score becomes -0.3. This means that, on average the student is 1 grade below their target in 3 out of 9 subjects.
