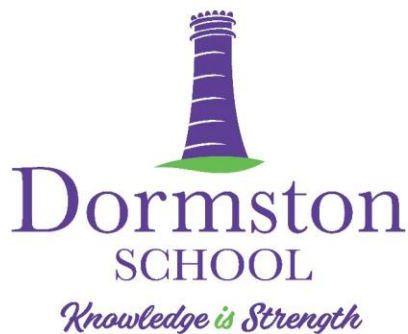

Re: Changes to PE Kit from September 2026

As part of our ongoing commitment to ensuring our school uniform remains in line with current government guidance on affordability and inclusivity, we are making some updates to our PE kit from September 2026.

These changes are designed to:

- Reduce costs for families
- Increase flexibility when purchasing items
- Promote comfort and confidence for all students

PE Kit Requirements from September

From September onwards, students will be required to wear:

- Plain black sport shorts (any make) **NOT** tight fitting
- Black and purple polo top with the school logo
- Plain black sports socks (any make)
- Trainers (any colour or make permitted)

In addition:

- A new **optional** quarter-zip training top with the school logo will be available.
- Football boots (no metal studs) are advisable

Important Changes

Skorts will no longer be permitted as part of the PE kit.

We are introducing **optional** black and purple PE leggings. We hope this additional option will support comfort and confidence.

Phasing In

All current PE kit items, **except for the skort**, may continue to be worn from September. These items will be gradually phased out as families purchase replacement kit.

We hope these changes provide greater flexibility while maintaining a strong sense of school identity. Our aim is to ensure PE kit remains practical, inclusive and affordable for all families.

Our uniform suppliers have all been informed of the changes.
